### **Beatty High School (BHS) GEAR UP Abstract**

The current 10<sup>th</sup> grade class of 36 students will be supported by GEAR UP this year. The diverse population includes; 2.1% American Indian/Alaskan Native, 3.3% Asian/Pacific Islander, 2.5% Hispanic, 1.7% African American, and 60.4% Caucasian. Sixty-four percent participate in free and/or reduced lunch.

The program at Beatty High is coordinated by the school counselor that has experience in GEAR UP. Students receive individualized counseling, tutoring, and test preparation. Students will take the ACT PLAN assessment. Emphasis will be placed on academic achievement, advanced course of study, and using good study skills. Continual monitoring of Individualized Learning Plans will take place between the student, parents, and counselor. College readiness skills will continue to be a focus while students explore career interests on Career Cruising™ and begin to develop an overall picture of college plans. Financial aid learning experiences will be offered through the partnerships with local colleges and banks with parents participating in the activities. Students will actively participate in community service and participate in summer camps, tutoring sessions, and enrichment activities.

Students will again participate in college visits and explore campuses in all areas of Nevada. Students that are identified with special interests will have the opportunity to contact and visit specialty colleges such as Le Cordon Bleu College, CCSN culinary arts program and Great Basin Tech Prep programs.
