NOTE: This is the first and only public hearing and possible action to adopt may be taken.

The need and the purpose of the proposed amendments are to separate the elementary physical education licensure from the elementary education licensure regulation in an effort to strengthen the physical education requirements and qualifications for those schools who have separate physical education teachers for elementary by developing a K-8 physical education license; and to increase the number of credits in the areas of mathematics, science and social studies.

There is no economic effect of the regulation on the public. There are no adverse effects. There are no immediate or long-term effects on the public. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the proposed regulation is none.
